WHEN: January 27th-30th, 2021

Jan. 27th: Gather at “launch sites” throughout St. Louis for programming: video message from our guest speaker, teen witnesses, prayer, and more!

Jan. 28th: Consider gathering as a group with resources provided by OYM

Jan. 29th: Consider gathering as a group to view the March—resources provided by OYM

Programming Tracks available:

-8th Grade Track (Group Registration opens on October 8th, 2020 @ 10:00am)

-High School Track (Group Registration opens on October 8th, 2020 @ 10:00am)

** Groups will attend the same launch site and rally location—programming for breakouts and that provided for Thursday & Friday will look different for each track**

Chaperone* Ratios:

Per Archdiocesan policy, each group must have **one chaperone for every ten teens**. We recognize that more adults may be needed for transportation so for this year only have lifted maximum chaperone regulations.

*All Chaperones must be 21 or older and in compliance with Archdiocesan Youth Ministry Policies.

COST: \$25.00 per person

At this price, each participant will receive a pass that grants them access to the launch site and Saturday's rally. Each registrant will also receive this year's give away item. All group leaders will have access to resources for Thursday and Friday nights to either distribute to their group or host their own gatherings.

Registration Information

Group Registration

The first step in registering is to register your school or church as a "Group" on October 8th, 2020 at 10:00am.

-A "Group" consists of one of the following two options:

- Only 8th Graders
- Only High School Teens

**If both an 8th grade and high school group will be attending from your parish, they will need to be registered as two separate groups, each with a designated group leader.

You will need the following information to register your Group:

For an 8th Grade Group:

For a High School Group:

- Number of Chaperones
- Number of Priests

*Young adults who attend with either an 8th grade or high school group will have a ministerial role. They must be between the ages of 18 and 21 and be in compliance with Archdiocesan Youth Ministry Policies.

**Please note that at the time of registration, every group leader will need to create a new username and password, even if the group has attended in the past.

Participant Individual Registration

After the Group Leader has registered the group and payment has been received by our Office, the Group Leader will receive a registration link via email. This link will need to be passed on to each participant in order for them to individually register online for the event.

Saturday Rally - Covid Options

Plan A: Every participant that registers will attend the rally in person - this location may be outdoors to accommodate all socially distanced

Plan B: If venues can only hold a small percentage, we will host two sessions of the rally

Plan C: If venues can only hold a small percentage, we will get as many in as possible, and live stream the rally back to the launch sites - this is when registration timing matters, the first to register will be given first option of attending in person

Plan D: If venues are not allowing anyone, we will live stream the rally to everyone at the launch sites

Plan E: If everyone is sheltered at home like this past spring, we will live stream to everyone at their homes
